**You must be able to swim continuously for 400 yards using each of the following strokes in a strong manner, in good form with rhythmic breathing, for at least 50 continuous yards: front crawl, sidestroke, breaststroke, and elementary backstroke.**

Scouts interested in participating in the Lifesaving Merit Badge Clinic **must be 2<sup>nd</sup> class Rank or higher.**

As **part** of this Merit Badge, the following 1<sup>st</sup> class Rank requirements will be met.

First Class rank requirements 6a, 6b, and 6e:

- 6a. Successfully complete the BSA swimmer test.
- 6b. Tell what precautions must be taken for a safe trip afloat.
- 6e. With a helper and a practice victim, show a line rescue both as tender and as rescuer.  
(The practice victim should be approximately 30 feet from shore in deep water.)

You will need:

- A Signed Blue Card
- Medical Form (A&B)
- Swim Suit & goggles
- 2 Towels
- Pants and Long sleeve shirt (may get wet)
- Dry Clothes for after
- Bag Lunch
- \$25 - Cash or Check made out to Two Rivers Family Swim club

Registration will be capped at 35. The first 35 boys to email [TuttleScoutsSTEM@gmail.com](mailto:TuttleScoutsSTEM@gmail.com) will be put on the registration list, time and date stamp will be used for priority.

As a bonus, please feel free to stay after the clinic and enjoy the facility which includes the lap pool and diving well.

Lifesaving merit badge is an option for the Eagle Scout rank.
